


2. Venue | Event center

The event center is situated at ASMILDKLOSTER AGRICULTURAL SCHOOL, with top facilities in order to host the World MTBO Championships.

It is right near the town center of Viborg. Easily accessible by car and public transport. Within 1 km you will find supermarkets, several restaurants and shops. In the event center you will find free massage, free wi-fi, MTBO related shops, bike mechanic, bike wash, bike storage, etc.

The event center will also be used at then 2019 pre-training camp and the Danish MTBO Camp.





4. Rules

The 2019 Championships will be organized in accordance with the Competition Rules for IOF MTB Orienteering Events, valid from $1^{\rm st}$ January 2018 and the Special Rules for the World Cup. However, an update is expected on $1^{\rm st}$ January 2019.

Riding off track

- Riding off the tracks will be permitted only in the sprint and relay competitions.
- In all other competitions; middle, long and mass start, riding, running and walking off the tracks will be <u>strictly</u> forbidden.

Controls situated outside paths/tracks

• In the sprint and relay competitions, controls can occur outside the tracks.







8. Time keeping system

SPORT*ident* Air+ will be used in all competitions.

The minimum working range is 150 cm.

All competitors will have to use an ActiveCard (SIAC). Rental will be possible.

Regarding back up cards; it is under consideration and we expect more information from the IOF MTBO Commission in near future. More information on the website and/or in bulletin #3.

9. Embargoed areas

The embargo is in place until after the WMTBOC 2019 in July/August 2019. The areas marked on the map are embargoed for all orienteering activities, unless specifically permitted by the organizers. The embargoed areas are out of bounds for all potential participants and team members, including competitors, team coaches, manager or anyone associated the team/individual.

Viborg City Center is totally embargoed!

Any permission for access into embargoed areas must be requested from the organizers, if needed and <u>before</u> access. This includes also if there are any MTB events taking place in the embargoed areas and potential competitors wish to participate. The embargo includes the use of drones in or about the terrain.



10. Classes & participation

Competitors participate at their own risk. Third party insurance and personal injury insurance is compulsory and shall be the responsibility of their federation or themselves, according to national regulations.

All competitors represent a federation. Each federation may enter a team of an unlimited number of competitors and a maximum number of 6 team officials.

World MTBO Championships

- There is one class for women and one for men. There are no age restrictions.
- In the mass start, middle distance and the sprint every federation may enter up to 6 women and 6 men and, in addition, the current World Champions for the distance may be entered by their federation(s) provided they are members of the federation's team.
- In the relay, each federation may enter 2 women's teams and 2 men's teams, each consisting of 3 team members. Incomplete teams and teams with cyclists from more than one federation are not allowed. Under no circumstances may persons other than entered competitors participate in the competition.
- For the long distance, the number of competitors who may enter is limited. The
 qualification rules are published as Special Rules decided by IOF Council and
 published at the latest by 31st January in the year of the competition.
- A competitor must have a valid IOF Athlete License.

Junior World MTBO Championships

- There is one class for women and one for men. Only competitors who are entitled to compete in the classes W20 or M20 may participate.
- In each competition every federation may enter up to 6 women and 6 men.

• In the relay, each federation may enter 2 women's teams and 2 men's teams, each consisting of 3 team members. Incomplete teams and teams with cyclists from more than one Federation are not allowed. Under no circumstances may persons other than entered competitors participate in the competition.

Welcome to the Viborg region, the heart of Jutland!

A visit to Viborg - called the "Heart of Jutland" - is a trip through history, culture and nature. Visitors will find a wonderful mixture of an historical medieval town and beautiful varied countryside. Almost 400 years ago a historian said: "Viborg is like the mother of Jutland". The history of Viborg can be traced back a very long time. Take a walk through the cobbled streets and imagine the bustle of life in the middle.

A modern municipality of growth

The Municipality of Viborg has more than 95,000 citizens. This makes us the 9th largest municipality and a very strong player on the municipal map of Denmark. Furthermore, the city of Viborg is the "capital" of the Region of Mid-Jutland. From Viborg City it takes you about 25 minutes to go to Karup Airport by car, within one hour you can get to Aalborg or Aarhus and within app. 3½ hours to get to Copenhagen.

Viborg is a dynamic, pulsating city, focusing on a good quality of life. The growth in the number of newcomers shows an increasing interest in living, learning and working in Viborg or one of the many small villages located in the beautiful landscape around Viborg. In our own quiet way, we are proud of Viborg today – and we are proud of our history.

The history of Viborg

Viborg is second oldest city in Denmark. The official formation of Viborg started around the year 1000, but the area had been a sacred rallying ground since ancient times. The name "Viborg" is a combination of the Danish words "Wii" - which means sacred - and "bjerg" - which means hill, i.e.: The sacred hill.

Viborg Cathedral was, after a huge City fire, rebuilt in 1864-1876 as a round-arched Romanesque granite church and is still an impressive feat of construction. Inside you can see huge wall-murals painted by Joakim Skovgaard.
